## **Parks & Recreation**

One popular feature of the neighborhood is the abundance of parks and green space. Haen Family Park, Sauk Creek Park, and Walnut Grove Park are only a short walk away from any neighborhood home. Another popular local destination is the High Point Pool, located at 901 N. High Point Road. Yet another strong selling point of the neighborhood is the close proximity to the public library. Alicia Ashman Library is located right across the street at 733 N. High Point Road. It's easy to "get local" in Sauk Creek.
